On the next page are the topics that we'll be covering this term. They are not an exhaustive list, but rather provide the key themes and questions that we will explore.

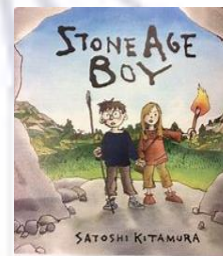
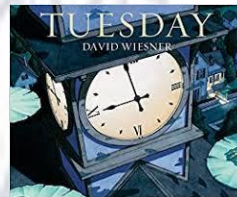
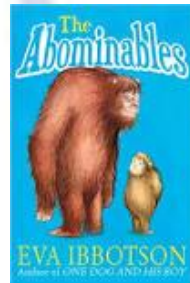
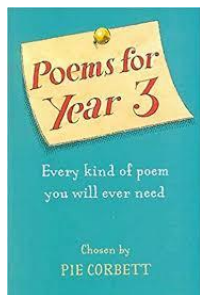
Reading will have a very high profile in school this academic year, and core texts will be used alongside artefacts and resources to support learning and deepen the children's understanding.
