



ST NICHOLAS CE PRIMARY SCHOOL SCHOOL UNIFORM

School uniform helps children feel that they belong to the school community. A strong sense of belonging supports positive attitudes towards school and learning.

Embroidered blue sweaters, cardigans, bags and PE polo shirts can be purchased directly from the online shop at [www.schooldaysdirect.co.uk](http://www schooldaysdirect.co.uk). There is no delivery charge if items are delivered to school; however, deliveries to school are made fortnightly.

All other items, such as white polo shirts, skirts and trousers, are widely available from supermarkets and department stores.

No jewellery should be worn at school. However, children may wear a small watch and one pair of small stud earrings. For health and safety reasons, jewellery cannot be worn during PE lessons. We therefore ask that earrings are not worn on PE days or that children are able to remove them independently for PE.

Where appropriate, the needs of different cultures, races and religions with regard to dress will be accommodated.

Uniform

- Royal blue sweater or cardigan embroidered with the school logo
- Grey long or short trousers, or grey skirt
- White plain cotton/polyester polo shirt
- Grey socks or tights and black shoes (not sandals)
- Light blue gingham summer dresses and white socks may be worn during the summer term

PE Uniform

- Blue polo shirt, embroidered with the school logo
- Plain black shorts, which should be just above the knee (not cycling shorts)
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms or leggings
- Plain black trainers

Children should wear their PE kit to school on PE days, with tracksuit bottoms in cooler weather. Children should wear their PE top with their usual school jumper.

Tights cannot be worn during PE lessons, so please ensure children also have a spare pair of socks in their bag. Football shirts, hoodies and patterned trousers are not part of the school PE kit.

Shoes with Velcro fastenings are recommended if your child is unable to tie their laces independently.

Hair

Hairstyles should not include extreme designs, such as shaved patterns or skin fades. Longer hair must be tied back. Hair bands, ties and ribbons should be in keeping with school colours and should not be large or decorative.

All clothing MUST be clearly marked with the child's name.
