Questions to Ask When Reading with Your Child

Below you will find a list of possible questions to help you with conversations about your child's reading. They are not intended to be used all at once or every time you read with your child. Use them at your discretion. Happy reading!

Questions to ask before you read

- Can you look at the pictures and predict what you think will happen in this book?
- What makes you think that?
- What characters do you think might be in our story?

Questions to ask during reading

- What do you think will happen next? How do you know?
- What has happened so far?
- How is that character feeling? How do you know?
- What do you know about this character so far?
- Can you predict how the story will end?
- Can you find a heading, the glossary, index, contents, caption? (For non-fiction books)

Questions to ask after reading

- Was there a problem? Did it get solved?
- What was your favourite part of the story? Why?
- Why did you like this book?
- Does this book remind you of any other books you have read? Why?
