This week we were pleased to see a return to school for the children. There are lots of events coming up; this week we have the first draw of *Your School Lottery* and next week the return of our Virtual Disco.

## Your School Lottery – the first draw is on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> March.

This is our new weekly lottery draw which not only raises vital money for the school but also gives our parents, staff, carers and the wider community a weekly chance to win a cash prize! Taking part is extremely simple as it takes just 1 minute to sign up. Tickets cost £1 per week and you can pay by direct debit or card payment. The draw takes place each Saturday and there is a **guaranteed school winner** every single week. The prize amount depends on how many tickets are in the draw so the more entries the bigger the prize.

There is also a chance to win the £25,000 jackpot by matching the winning six-digit number. There were 8 lucky jackpot winners in 2020 so it does happen!

For every £1 ticket bought, 40p goes to the school. This adds up to £1,000 per year for just 50 weekly tickets, just think what this money can buy for the children.
