### **Dexie Returns to School**

At St Nicholas, we are very lucky to have our very own School Wellbeing Dog, Dexie. Dexie is a cavapoo and she lives with Mrs Hilling.

Children can benefit educationally and emotionally, increase their understanding of responsibility and develop empathy and nurturing skills through contact with a dog. In addition to these benefits, children take great enjoyment from interaction with a dog After being furloughed due to school closures during the first lockdown, Dexie is joining us for one day a week while she readjusts to her valued role in school.

Last week, all classes were involved in an interactive educational talk from the Blue Cross on Dog Safety and understanding dog body language. The children enjoyed the session and learned when it is OK to say hello to Dexie and when she prefers to be left alone. They learned about safely meeting dogs outside of school. I wonder how many of them remember the three C's?:

**Check** with the owner. Give the dog a **Choice**, **Count** three strokes.
