The short, multi-lap, events ensure excitement and thrills for everyone and exercise both bike-handling skill and fitness. Races are run for a fixed time rather than a fixed distance and the time is set to suit the age of the riders.

Summer CX is the least stressed, most fun and friendliest format and is ideal for anyone who wants to try cycle sport in a safe, local setting.

Starting on Wednesday 9 June 2021 and continuing on 16,13 and 30 June, there are separate races for U10, U12, Youth Boys, Youth Girls, Adult Women and Adult Men. So there is a race for everyone in the family. There are no leagues, and no prizes but all races benefit from full electronic timing so that you can track your
