In June 2022 I trialed for a place in the Wokingham District Primary Schools Football Team. I was chosen along with 13 other Year 5 and Year 6 boys from the area to represent Wokingham District for the 2022/23 season.

My team have been playing home and away matches all season in league and cup matches and are currently in the final of the Shires Cup and the Southern Counties League cup, both of which are being held in May.

Over the Easter holidays the team attended the 47th Jersey Primary Football Festival held in Jersey and represented Wokingham District playing matches against teams such as Gloucester, Hackney, Newbury and Plymouth. The team won 2 matches, drew 2 matches and lost 2 matches. I played in every match and in the game against Hackney, I was Player of the Match where I played in my favourite position of Central Attacking Midfielder and assisted 2 of the goals in a 5-1 victory. We played matches every morning of the tour and then spent the afternoons exploring the island and beaches.


Seating will be provided on the field or you are welcome to bring your own chairs/rug if you prefer along with any picnic food/snacks if you wish.
