
We think Mr Phillips did an amazing job of being Headteacher for the day and certainly has the foundations for becoming a great leader in a future career!




Giovanna, Sophie and Colette teamed up and sold sweetie mix cones.

It takes a village to put on a show, so any time people can give to support is much appreciated, however little or much! It's a fun way to meet other villagers and give a bit back to our community.



Early bird ticket prices are valid until the 31st May at £18.00 each, then the price increases to £20.00 each


