

## End of KS2 Performance Data 2023-2024

### Provisional End of KS2 Performance Data – 20223/24

#### Attainment

At the end of KS2, pupils sit a test in reading, mathematics and SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar). Pupils are assessed by their class teacher in writing.

The table below shows the percentage of pupils that achieved the 'expected standard' and a 'high level'.
